General aspects

- Have a personal computer on which you have administrator rights
- Have a strong, stable, secured and personal internet connection

During the Exam

- An ID document with photo is required during the identification procedure
- No breaks are allowed you must be in front of your camera at all times during the exam
- You cannot use pen or paper
- You cannot use your phone
- A calculator is integrated in the exam software should you need it



Exam Room

- The room must be well-lit, clear and you must be visible at all times
- Your desk must be clear of any unauthorised materials
- Make sure you take the exam in a quiet, private

space
